1. Updated PhilGEPS Registration Certificate (if expired a particular documents in the Annex "A" please attach an updated Certificate/ Permit and/or Official Receipt for renewal)

B. Technical Documents

1. Updated Certificate of Product Registration (certified true copy by the Consignor)
(Applicable for Consignment of Drugs & Medicines Only)
2. Sworn statement that the prospective Consignor has not been "blacklisted" to participate in biddings by any Government Agency
3. License to Operate issued by the Food and Drug Administration
4. Certificate of Satisfactory Performance from at least three clients (either government and/or private clients) from 2017 to Present *(Applicable for Consignment of Drugs & Medicines Only)*
5. Certificate of Exclusive Distributorship / Dealership

Terms and Conditions: *(Applicable for Consignment of Drugs & Medicines Only)*

1. Drugs and Medicines used for product analysis in DOH-FDA shall be replaced by the supplier.
2. Drugs that will not conform to the standard specifications shall be returned to the company.
